OVER-NIGHTER PACKING LIST

- Bible, pen/pencil, notebook
- Clothing for two days (it will be on the chilly side, but we will also be having activities in the gym)
- Shower shoes (flip flops, crocs, or sandals)
- Shower supplies & towel
- Any night-time/morning care items such as deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.
- Pillow & bedding or sleeping bag
- Any necessary medication (must be in original container or noted by a parent) – is to be turned in to the First Aid Attendant or Student Pastor at check-in

Over-Nighter rules:

- Respect others and yourself
- No guys in girls' cabin or girls in the guys' cabin
- Alcohol, tobacco, vaping, drugs and weapons are absolutely prohibited (this includes pocket knives)
- Everyone must be in their dorms by the designated time
- Follow the schedule. Be where you are supposed to be when you are supposed to be there
- Do not leave the chapel once the session starts
- Respect the camp grounds – no trash left, looks better than when we arrived
- We ask that students **DO NOT** bring any snacks or food into the dorms. Water bottles are fine.
- During “lights out”, every student is either asleep or silent. Any student causing issues for other students during this time will have their parent/guardian contacted at that time for immediate pick up. This includes: any conversations, volume from cellphones (headphones are permitted), or any other disturbance besides necessary restroom usage. Dorm leaders will let students know when “out of bunk” time will be in the morning.

CELL PHONES: Students may bring them if desired. If they become an issue, the student pastor or an adult leader will confiscate them, and they will be returned to a parent/guardian at the end of the trip.

IN CABIN TIME: Students will not leave the cabins until the leaders dismiss. Students will be required to remain in their bunk until the designated time by leaders – restroom usage is the only exception. Students are welcome to bring headphones, but will not disturb others with music/videos. If a student is causing the rest of their cabin to not fall asleep or anything of that nature, a parent will be called to pick up their student regardless of what time it is
